TOEFL: minimum score of 600 (250 CBT; 80 iBT)

GRE: submission of GRE scores is required; each program has a different GRE score requirement

GMAT: submission of GMAT scores is required for applicants to the MBA.

Applicants must not be older than 25 years old at the time of application Graduates who have studied overseas are not eligible

Preference will be given to applicants who have no or not more than one semester of graduate work. Applicants with graduate degrees shall not be eligible for the same academic disciplines.
