|                  | • Have completed 2 semesters of study at home university, with proof of results.  |
|                  | • NTU will only review student applications that are nominated and formally submitted to NTU International Relations Office (IRO) by the exchange coordinators of exchange partner universities.  |
|                  | • Each NTU partner institutions <b>should not submit more than five (5)</b> applications, unless otherwise indicated, for NTU's review.   |
|                  | • Each nominee should be from different faculty/schools.  |
|                  | <ul> <li>Applicants should possess the following:</li> <li>a) An excellent academic record - within the top 5% of cohort</li> <li>b) A very good command of the English Language</li> <li>c) Hold leadership positions in any of university student activity clubs</li> </ul> |
